POSITION SUMMARY

Join our team as our campus hosts different events through our spring, fall and summer seasons. As an event staff member you'll help for maintain clean spaces, accommodate guests and ensure smooth event operations. To be successful in this role, staff should possess strong communication & problem-solving skills. This position provides an opportunity to gain experience in the hospitality field while working in an outdoor environment.

JOB RESPONSIBILITIES

For Cleaners

- Maintain Cleanliness of all used spaces on campus.
- Trash and litter removal at the end of the event.
- Cleaning and restocking bathrooms.
- Sweeping concessions areas during the event.

For Parking Attendants

- Direct vehicles to available parking spaces & ensure smooth traffic flow.
- Greet guests in a warm & welcoming manner.
- Assist guests in finding the event space.
- Can anticipate the guests needs.
- Effectively communicate with event manager to resolve any issues with guests in a friendly & professional manner.
- Other duties as assigned.

For Ushers

- Greet guests when they arrive & guide them to designated event areas.
- Assist guests with any special needs or requests.
- Monitor the event area to ensure guests remain seated & follow event rules.



- Distribute programs, materials or other event items to guests.
- Respond to guest inquiries and provide helpful information about the event schedule or venue.
- Help manage crowd control during high-traffic times, such as entry & exit.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Must be at least 18 years old.
- Ability to meet the physical demands of the job, which includes standing and walking for long periods of time and lifting heavy loads up to 50 pounds.
- Strong interpersonal skills required.
- Customer service skills preferred.
- Ability to work in a fast-paced environment.
- Ability to work nights, weekends, and irregular hours.
- Willing & able to work outdoors during some light precipitation.
- Capacity to work both independently and as a team.
- Ability to take direction and complete tasks assigned by supervisors.
- Honest and ethical.
- Can-do attitude with the ability to find “yes”.
- Ability to maintain a positive outlook and a “go with the flow” attitude.
- Have a reliable means of transportation.
- Ability to be punctual and reliable.
- Must complete New York State required trainings, including but not limited to a Sexual Harassment Prevention training and a Child Abuse and Neglect/Maltreatment Identification. Links to required trainings will be provided after hiring.
- CPR training is not required but a plus.

Have reliable transportation to Usdan’s campus. Requests for accommodations are subject to approval by senior management.

SEASON DATES AND TIMES

This position will be on-call with varying shifts as events are scheduled.

COMPENSATION

PHYSICAL DEMANDS

Usdan is a 140-acre campus with facilities spread throughout - distances vary and are along uneven surfaces, up and down hills. Some facilities are elevated and require one to two stairs to enter.
