ABOUT USDAN

Each summer, teachers and artists – actors, directors, playwrights, painters, sculptors, musicians, composers, dancers, poets, and novelists – come together to teach and collaborate with our campers, ages 5 to 18. Set on 140 acres of natural beauty in Wheatley Heights, Long Island, NY. Usdan is a safe, welcoming place within which campers have the freedom to build new friendships, explore nature, gain personal independence, and have fun, while developing new skills and techniques in their chosen artforms.

POSITION SUMMARY

Usdan is seeking a dynamic and enthusiastic Band Conductor to join our Music Department. The Band Conductor will be responsible for directing and leading a student band and cultivating and engaging in a supportive environment where students can develop their musical skills. As part of a team of talented arts professionals, the Band Conductor will provide mentorship, guidance and musical instruction while fostering creativity and a love for music.

JOB RESPONSIBILITIES

- Lead and direct student band rehearsals and festival performances, focusing on technique, ensemble cohesion and performance preparation.
- Provide individualized guidance to students, helping improve their musical skill and understanding of music theory.
- Work closely with other music faculty, including assistant teachers and Department Chair, to enhance the overall music program experience in and outside the studio.
- Carry out class instruction and formatively assess students.
- Prepare and organize the setup of any needed materials in the studio.
- Supervise students throughout the camp day (including at daily assemblies and when traveling between studios).
- Attend department and staff meetings and trainings as required.
- Use unstructured time constructively.
- Always have student safety as a top priority.
- Help to create a joyful, fun and engaging atmosphere for all students and staff at Usdan.
- Model the behaviors of artists; how they think, work, and live.
- Other duties as assigned.

The above job description is not intended to be an all-inclusive list of duties and standards of the position. The Band Conductor will be expected to follow any other instructions, and perform any other related duties, as assigned by their supervisor.



QUALIFICATIONS

- A strong background in music, particularly in conducting and teaching band or ensemble.
- Bachelor's degree in your art form, education, or equivalent knowledge, skills, and abilities.
- 3+ years of prior successful teaching experience.
- An active artistic practice.
- Experience working with children.
- Be able to work individually and as a part of a team.
- Must complete New York State required trainings, including but not limited to a Sexual Harassment Prevention training and a Child Abuse and Neglect/Maltreatment Identification. Links to required trainings will be provided after hiring.
- CPR training is not required but a plus.
- Have reliable transportation to Usdan's campus. Requests for accommodations are subject to approval by senior management.

COMPENSATION AND BENEFITS

- \$8,000 Stipend, at least 30 hours per week in season.
- Family orientation, staff orientation, and any additional approved studio prep time will be paid at an hourly rate of \$25.
- An additional \$439.50 will be provided for each period of conducting, up to a maximum of \$1,758.
- Complimentary use of studio space for their own artistic purposes, pre- and post-season, pending availability; semi-weekly use of swimming pool after camp hours; and occasional use of other facilities (e.g. tennis courts).
- Workshops in subjects like yoga, ceramics, and archery with other faculty and staff, if offered.
- Transportation: additional opportunities to serve as a bus monitor, which consists of riding the bus to and from camp and supervising students. Faculty and staff will receive a stipend (\$400-\$700)

PHYSICAL DEMANDS

Usdan is a 140-acre campus with facilities spread throughout - distances vary and are along uneven surfaces, up and down hills. Some facilities are elevated and require one to two stairs to enter.

Some staff walk an average of two miles per day. Other physical demands include the ability to work in a hot, humid environment; the ability to speak clearly and understand the speech of another person; and the ability to prioritize sounds and focus on one sound among many.

The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential physical functions of this position.
